UPDATE OF SCHOOL MATTERS FOR TERM 3, 2017

Changes to recesses and school hours

To enable students to have better meal time and sufficient break for the body and mind, our school will be introducing two recesses (Monday to Thursday) with effect from Term 3 this year.

- Lower Sec recesses will be 8.45-9.15 am and 12.15-12.45pm while Upper Sec recesses will be 9.45-10.15am and 1.15-1.45pm [the half hour interval between the Lower and Upper Sec recesses is to provide sufficient time for our canteen stallholders to prepare for the next recess]. There will no longer be any need for 5 minute snack break
- Although the recess time has been brought forward by one hour for all students as compared to previous timing, students are advised to have proper breakfast before they come to school
- Due to the additional recess, a typical lower sec school day will end at 2.45pm for all students while a typical upper sec school day will end at 1.15pm for NA and at 2.45pm for Exp/NT students
- Fridays will continue to have only one recess at 8.45-9.15am for Lower Sec and 9.45-10.15am for Upper Sec. Form Teacher Period will be moved to Wed 2.45-3.15pm and Fridays will end at 12.15pm instead of 12.45pm for all students except 4E5.
- CCA will be from 3.30-6.00pm on Wednesdays and 2.00-6.00pm on Fridays in general [Exact days/times/duration may vary among different CCAs]

Improvement of school facilities and infrastructure

We have renovated our school library with the hope that more students will make good use of the library after school hours and that the new discussion room will encourage more collaborative learning and group work. We have also renovated our gymnasium with new equipment and air-conditioning, which will be open for all students every Mon and Tue, 3-5pm, with effect from Term 3. The gym will benefit PE lessons and sports CCA, in addition to encouraging students to keep fit and trim. We have also just obtained MOE funding for the building of a pedestrian walkway from the main gate to improve the human/vehicular traffic situation outside our main gate during morning peak hours. Construction has commenced and the walkway is expected to be completed by end of July.

Punctuality for School

To further instil self-discipline, with effect from Term 3, students who come to school after **8.00am** without valid reasons will chalk up two counts of latecoming (instead of one), but will be allowed to go for lessons. Students who come to school after **9.00am** without valid reasons will be stopped by security guards at the gate and not allowed to enter the school. Those who have valid reasons should inform their parents/guardians to call the general office for verification. Habitual late-comers (i.e. more than 4 times late per semester) will be disciplined and counselled. Disciplinary measures include detention class after school and/or suspension from class/school. Students who are late more than 8 times in a year may receive a conduct grade no better than "Good".

Posting of Allied Educator (Learning and Behavioural Support)

Our school has been posted an AED (LBS), Miss Bai Huiying, who will provide more structured and systematic support to students with mild special educational needs (SEN) and enable them to integrate better in school. Her duties include providing in-class and/or individual and small group intervention, transition support and skills training in work habits, facilitating social support groups etc for students with SEN. We encourage students/parents to seek her help when necessary.
