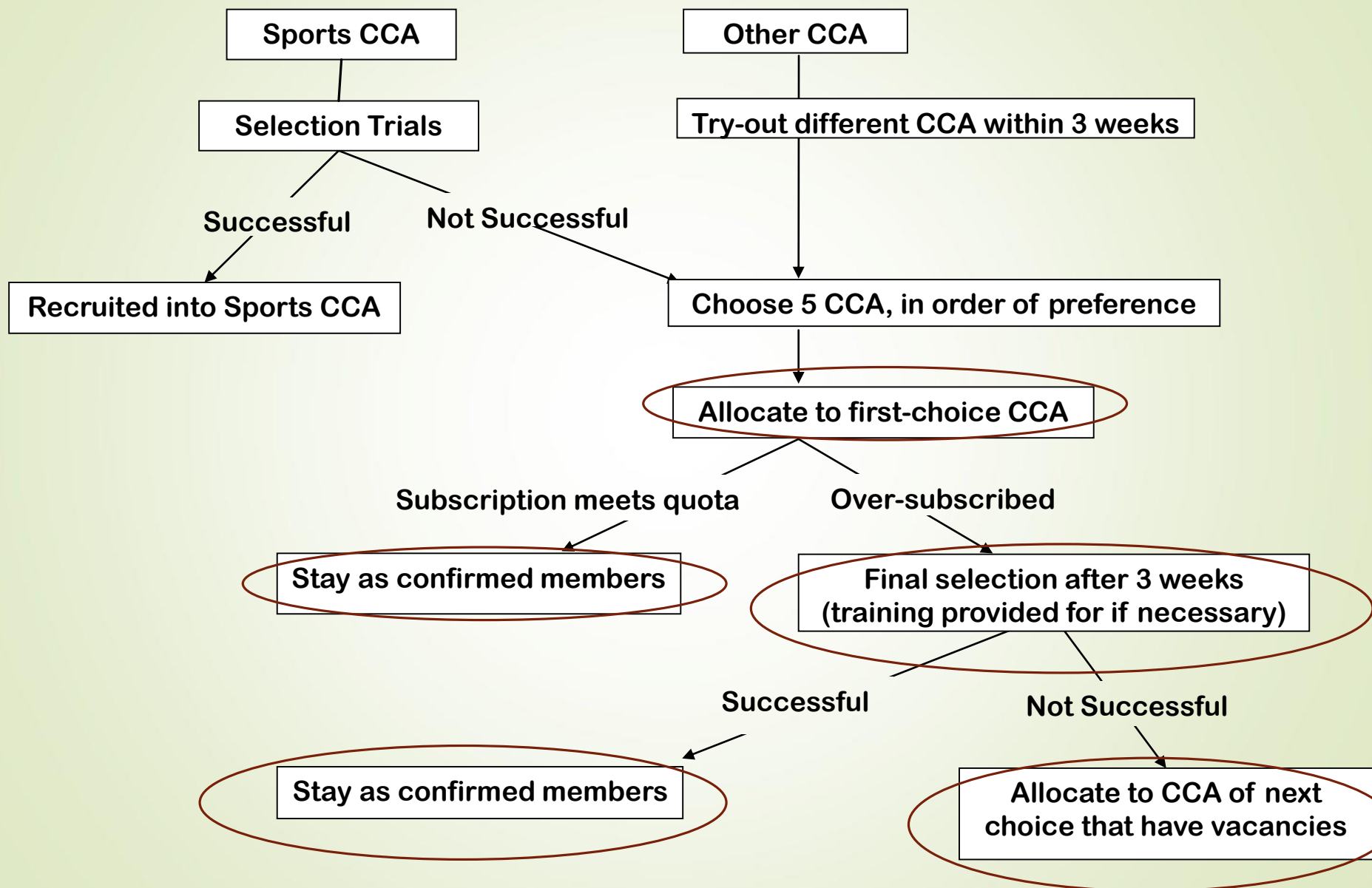
CCA Open House
